## BCSC Summer Food Service Programs

The Summer Food Service Program provides free breakfast and lunch to children ages 18 and under at public schools, parks, pools, and libraries. Children are eligible for these meals (enrolled or not in public schools). No identification or registration is required. Meals are also provided to adults at a low cost. The Summer Meals Program runs from late May through August. Dates and hours vary by location.
